Alliance Française de Brisbane French Film Festival 2017 Short Film Competition Terms and conditions

CONTEXT AND GENERAL OVERVIEW

Context of the video / short film competition

The AFB invites you to participate in the Short Film Competition.

The Short Film Competition encourages Australian Year 11 and Year 12 students of French to submit a short film based on one of the ten words issued by the 2017 Dis-moi dix mots event that celebrates French language.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Theme: The video must address one of the 10 words.

Duration: The video must be of minimum 1 to 3 minutes.

Format and posting of the video: the video must have a sound track. It can include photos, illustrations, sketches, and/or words. It must be posted on a YouTube account, and the link must be pasted onto the registration form.

Language: French.

Age of participants and other requirements: The competition is open to Queensland Year 11 and Year 12 students of French.

Authorship: By submitting his/her video, the applicant declares that he/she is the sole author of the work. In case of a collaborative work, co-authors must be acknowledged.

Submission and deadline: The link to the video must be submitted via the registration form at claire@afbrisbane.com before the competition deadline of Friday 24 February 2017, 5pm. Submissions received after the deadline will not be accepted. Only one submission per person/group will be accepted.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The videos will be judged according to the interpretation of the theme

The selection committee will judge the videos based on the following criteria:

- Respect of the instructions
- Coherence
- Quality of the message
- Creativity
- Quality of audio track and film editing

SELECTION PANEL

Closing Date: 24 February 2017

The **best short film** for year 11 and the best short film for year 12 will be chosen by 28 February 2017 by a jury composed of:

- The director of Alliance Française
- The culture manager at Alliance Française
- 2 French teachers

Winners will be announced at a soiree at Alliance Francaise on 3rd March.

PRIZES

The winners will be entitled to receive passes to see French films of their choice during the Alliance Française French Film Festival 2017. Terms and conditions apply.

The short films will appear on Alliance française website.

AUTHORISATION

The Alliance Française de Brisbane reserves the right to use the 2 videos (1 for each year) shortlisted by the jury for any public relation purposes, including on social media and websites.

When submitting the videos, the videos become the ownership of Alliance Française.

SELECTION AND JURISDICTION

By submitting a video to the competition, the participants agree to abide the afore mentioned rules and conditions of entry.

RESULTS

The winner for best video will be notified by phone/email on Tuesday 28 February 2017 and will be invited to the ceremony on the 3rd March.
